WHAT WOULD MY DAY LOOK LIKE?

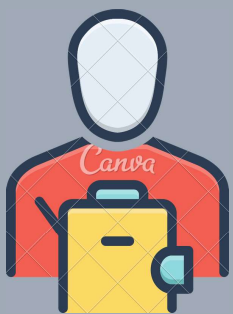
