

LLOYD JENSON 102 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Lloyd Jenson has been an active member of the Air Cadet Program for over 35 years. Over the course of his 35 years Lloyd truly came to appreciate the value of the Air Cadet Program and the positive influence it has on its members. For this reason, 102 Squadron re-named this scholarship the Lloyd Jensen Scholarship in recognition of Lloyd's pioneering efforts.

Applicants must be graduates of the secondary school system (or equivalent) in the year of application, and who are entering directly into a full program of studies at a fully-accredited postsecondary education facility (university, college, cegep, technical institute or vocational program) where the program undertaken leads to a degree, diploma, or professional or technical qualification.

Additionally, you must have completed level 2, at a minimum, of the Air Cadet Program.

How to apply:

- A statement of approximately 500-700 words outlining your career goals and objectives; including an explanation on why you wish to attend the institution you have chosen, and what benefits you will gain from post-secondary education;
- A statement of approximately 300-500 words explaining what the Air Cadet Program means to you;
- A copy of the most recently available Transcript of Marks.

Submit all required information by email to sponsor_chair@102squadron.com before 11:59pm Monday May 13th, 2019.

Applicants will be graded based on their cadet record, essays and interview. The transcript of marks will only be used if two applicants are tied in all other categories.

All applicants that meet the above criteria will be notified of their scheduled personal interview which will be conducted on Monday May 27th, 2019. The interview will be conducted in person by the Scholarship Committee which will consist of one staff member and two members of the Squadron Sponsoring committee.
